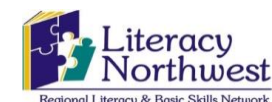
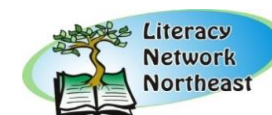
- ❖ Understanding the difference between task-based and skills-based assessment
